

SAFE DRINKING WATER REPORT – 11/4/2021

PER SOM REQUIREMENTS, THE VILLAGE REGULARLY TESTS WATER SAMPLES FROM INTERIOR FAUCETS TO CHECK FOR LEAD/COPPER CONTAMINATION.

7 SAMPLES FROM DIFFERENT LOCATIONS WERE REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED, OF THOSE 7 SAMPLES, 1 LOCATION HAD ELEVATED LEAD AT THE TEST TIME, WHICH PUT THE VILLAGE OVER THE 90TH PERCENTILE VALUE OF SAMPLES.

DUE TO THE SIZE OF OUR VILLAGE AND THE AMOUNT OF SAMPLING REQUIRED, 1 ELEVATED SAMPLE AUTOMATICALLY PUTS THE VILLAGE AT THIS LEVEL.

THIS COMMERCIAL WATER CUSTOMER (NOT A PRIVATE RESIDENCE) WAS IMMEDIATELY NOTIFIED OF THE RESULTS AND THE VILLAGE IMMEDIATELY STARTED WORKING WITH EGLE AND DHHS TO PUT TOGETHER A PROGRAM TO PROTECT OUR COMMUNITY'S HEALTH WITH CLEAN, SAFE DRINKING WATER.

WE HAVE RESAMPLED THIS SAME CUSTOMERS WATER, AND TODAY THE RESULTS HAVE SHOWN THAT THERE IS NO DETECTABLE LEAD IN THIS SYSTEM. IN 2018 THIS SAME LOCATION SHOWED NO DETECTABLE LEAD.

AS WE MOVE FORWARD TO ENSURE OUR COMMUNITY STAYS HEALTHY, WE ARE GOING TO DOUBLE OUR SAMPLING SITES FOR 2 - 6 MONTH ROUNDS TO EVALUATE THE RESULTS. WE HAVE ADDED 2 ADDITIONAL TESTS SAMPLES OF THE VILLAGE WELLS AND IN THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM. THIS WILL GIVE US DATA DRIVEN INFORMATION HELPING US MAKE DECISIONS ABOUT ANY ADJUSTMENTS OR CHANGES THAT MAY NEEDED TO REDUCE CORROSION AND LEAD LEVELS FOR ALL WATER CUSTOMERS.

AS WE CONTINUE, WE ENCOURAGE ALL CUSTOMERS TO CHECK THE VILLAGE WEBSITE, DRINKING WATER TAB, FOR EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION AND RESOURCES SUPPLIED BY THE SOM. WE WILL BE UPDATING THIS SITE WITH ALL NEW INFORMATION AS WE MOVE FORWARD WITH OUR SAFE DRINKING WATER PROGRAM.
